



DOG LICENSE

What's New for 2019?

We have a new three-year dog license option. **All** dog licenses will now expire on the same month as the rabies expiration date. One year licenses will still be available. Rabies vaccines can be renewed anytime in the MONTH in which it expires. Please bring proof of rabies vaccine. The new fee schedule is as follows:

Dog License Fees:

Tags for service dogs can only be purchased at the Livingston County Treasurer's Office in Howell.

Dog License Fees	1 Year	3 Year*
Current Spayed/Neutered	\$10.00	\$25.00
Current Male/Female	\$25.00	\$60.00
Late Fee	\$20.00	\$20.00
Replacement License (Lost Tag)	\$5.00	\$5.00
<i>*The rabies vaccination must be valid for the entire 3 year period.</i>		

License Expirations:

Dog Licenses now expire when the rabies vaccination expires.

The County Treasurer's office will send reminder postcards 60 days prior to the rabies expiration date. Check your rabies expiration date to see if you need to set up an appointment with your veterinarian. Rabies vaccinations can be administered by your vet, any day of the month that the vaccination expires.

NEW 3 Year Dog Licenses - Rabies Vaccination must cover the complete licensing period. You may find that you must purchase 1 year licenses until your dog becomes eligible for a 3 year license.

Your next license **MUST** be purchased by the end of the RABIES EXPIRATION MONTH or a \$20 late fee will be added to the cost of your dog license.
