December 31, 2016	The status of a property on "tax day" determines 2017 values and taxes
First Week of January 2017	Annual personal property statements mailed out to businesses in Green Oak Twp.
February 10, 2017	Annual State deadline to file Affidavit to Claim Small Business Exemption, form 5076
February 14, 2017	2016 Winter taxes due without late penalty
February 16, 2017	Annual Assessment Change Notices mailed
February 21, 2017	State deadline for filing 2017 Personal Property Statement, form 632
February 21, 2017	State deadline for filing 2017 Eligible Manufacturing Personal Property Exemption, form 5278
March, 7 2017	2017 March Board of Review (MBOR) Organizational meeting
March, 13, 14, 15, 2017	2017 March Board of Review (MBOR) Appeal Meetings held
May 31, 2017	Deadline for filing commercial, industrial and utility real and personal property appeals with the Michigan Tax Tribunal (MTT).
June 1, 2017	Deadline for filing Principle Residence Exemption Affidavit, form 2368 for Brighton and South Lyon school districts. Must own & occupy as residence on June 1 st to be eligible
June 30, 2017	Deadline for filing property classification appeal with the State Tax Commission (STC). File with the STC in writing on form 2167. MBOR appeal required
First Week of July 2017	2017 Summer Tax Bills Mailed
July 18, 2017	July Board of Review (JBOR) meets to correct clerical errors, mutual mistakes, homesteads and poverty exemptions as verified by the assessor. (No public appeals heard)
July 31, 2017	A protest of assessed valuation ore taxable valuation or the percentage of qualified agricultural exemption subsequent March Board of Review action, must be filed with the Michigan Tax Tribunal (MTT)
August 1, 2017	Deadline for filing residential and agricultural property appeals with the Michigan Tax Tribunal (MTT)
November 1, 2017	Deadline for filing Principle Residence Exemption Affidavit, form 2368 for Whitmore Lake school district. Must own & occupy as residence on November 1 st to be eligible
First Week of December 2017	2017 Winter tax bills mailed
December 12, 2017	December Board of Review (DBOR) meets to correct clerical errors, mutual mistakes, homesteads and poverty exemptions as verified by assessor. (No public appeals heard)
